Festival band

At the European TEN SING conference in February 2010 we announced that we invite all countries to suggest people to be part of the festival band. We are looking for skilled musicians that will fit well in a festival band.

Please send applications, which should include a presentation of the person and an example of the person playing, to **office@ets2011.eu** by the end of October 31th 2010.

Some of the elements in the band are already fixed. We are therefor looking for a percussionist, a pianist, a guitarist and vocalists.

Festival hosts

At the main stage programme we are planning on having two hosts to guide us through the programme all week. It will be a boy and a girl, one

from Germany and the other from another TS country.

We are looking for a person that speaks English on a high level and that will handle the pressure of standing in front of 3000 Ten Singers and lead them through the programme in a good way. Please send applications to **office@ets2011.eu**. The application should include a video where the applicant presents himself/herself in English and why he/her are fit to be a host. Deadline for applications is November 30th 2010.



Festival song

There will be a festival song, and we invite you to compose it. The song song should be an uptempo song that's easy to sing a long to, and the lyrics should be relatable to the festival.

Please send in the song with a notesheet and lyrics and preferably a recorded version of it to **office@ets2011.eu** by January 31th 2011.

The festival reserves the right to change recieved contributions, after agreement with the composer. The festival owns the right to the chosen festival song.

We hope that you will help us getting the best people from all over Europe to be part of these key elements at the festival. We are looking forward to see you at the festival next summer.
