## The Loreley

The ESG Jamboree will take place on the rock called "Loreley" above the river Rhine, 132 metres high. This unique landscape is listed in the UNESCO world heritage. It is situated near St. Goarshausen in the federal state of Rheinland-Pfalz and offers a breath-taking view over the Rhine valley. The Loreley is a legendary rock and world-famous of the myth of the singing mermaid leading astray the passing fishermen.



Accommodation is supplied in the Sports- and Youth-Hostel Loreley. There is a vast camp site and a large hall for our activities.
